1. Course Courtesy:

- Replace divots and repair ball marks on the greens.
- Keep carts on designated paths and away from greens and hazards.

2. Pace of Play:

- Be aware of your group's pace and keep up with the group in front.
- Be ready to hit when it's your turn, and limit practice swings.

3. Quiet on the Green:

- Avoid talking or making unnecessary noise when others are putting.
- Stand still and be attentive while others are playing.

4. Cell Phones:

- Silence or turn off cell phones to maintain a quiet atmosphere.
- Use phones for emergencies only and away from play.

5. Ready Golf:

- Be prepared for your shot before it's your turn.
- Play "ready golf" during casual rounds to maintain a good pace.

6. Lost Ball Search:

- Limit ball search time to a few minutes to keep the game moving.
- Allow faster groups to play through if you are searching for a lost ball.

7. Raking Bunkers:

- Smooth out sand in bunkers with a rake after playing a shot.
- Enter and exit bunkers from the low side when possible.

8. Golf Cart Etiquette:

- Follow cart path rules and observe any posted signs.
- Park carts away from greens and tees to minimize damage.

9. Honoring Tee Times:

- Arrive on time for tee times and be ready to play.
- Allow faster groups to play through if you are slower.
- **10. Respect for Others:** Avoid distracting movements or noise during another player's swing. Congratulate and support fellow golfers, regardless of skill level.
