Golf Cart Maintenance Checklist

Weekly

- Tires: Check inflation and wear.
- Battery: Ensure charge, clean terminals, and add distilled water if needed.
- Cleanliness: Wash exterior, wipe seats.
- Brakes: Test functionality and inspect pads.

Monthly

- Battery: Clean terminals, check cables.
- Tires: Rotate for even wear.
- Steering/Suspension: Inspect for smooth operation and wear.
- Lights: Test and replace burnt bulbs.

Quarterly

- Fluids: Check and top up brake fluid and others.
- Wiring: Look for frayed wires or loose connections.

- Battery: Perform load test.
- Belts/Hoses: Inspect for wear or cracks.
- Brakes: Clean and adjust.
- Motor: Service as needed.

Annual

- Full Inspection: Check all components.
- **Professional Service:** Consider professional maintenance.
- Battery: Replace if needed.
- Alignment: Ensure proper wheel alignment.

Tips

- Follow the manufacturer's guidelines.
- Keep a maintenance log.
- Use the cart regularly.
- Store in a dry, sheltered area.
